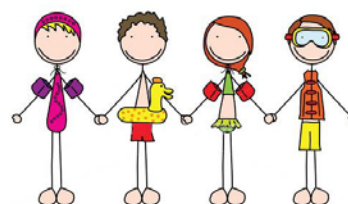


### PRIMARY SWIMMING CARNIVAL

### Community Helpers – WWCC

We love having parent and community helpers for organized school activities.

If you would like to help out at school, please ensure you have given a printed copy of your Volunteers' Working With Children Check to the office. These can be filled in online - <https://wwccheck.cyp.nsw.gov.au/Applicant/s/Application> Your name will then be added to our Volunteers Register.

### Supervision

At Moama Public School the teaching staff are on duty from 8.35a.m. to 3.05p.m. It is best practice for students to leave home at a time which will see them arrive at 8.35a.m. or shortly thereafter. Students who arrive before this time will not be supervised, and are required to sit quietly outside on the verandah seats.

During recess and lunch the teachers are rostered to supervise designated playing areas. If your child has a problem, or is feeling unwell during this time, he/she is required to report to the duty teacher who will determine the next step if required.

Students are not permitted to take themselves to the office without a note from the duty teacher. This ensures the office staff always receive the correct message from the teacher, and can help your child in an appropriate manner.

### PAYMENT REMINDERS

#### School Fees

Your voluntary contribution fee can be paid at the front office or online using the PAYPOP (Parent Pay Online) facility on our school website. You will find this on the front page under 'Make a Payment'.

### Absences

Just a reminder that if your child is absent, an explanation is required on the day your child returns to school. You are also able to send an absence note via the School Stream phone app. These records are kept for 7 years by law. Frequent absences can disrupt the continuity of a student's learning. Whilst your child should be kept at home when they are unwell it's preferred that appointments, where possible, be made out of school time. The Home School Liaison Officer visits the school on a regular basis to check attendance. If your child arrives to school late, or is early to leave, you are required to attend the office to complete a sign in/out form and will be given a pass which must be given to their teacher.

### Special Religious Education (SRE) classes

Next Wednesday 20<sup>th</sup> February all classes from Kindergarten to Year 6 will commence Special Religious Education. Special Religious Education is education in the beliefs and practices of an approved religious persuasion by authorised representatives.

At Moama Public School SRE is taught by accredited providers who provide non-denominational lessons.

If you do not wish for your child to participate in SRE please forward a signed note to the principal by next Monday 18<sup>th</sup> February. Students who do not participate in SRE lessons will engage in alternate meaningful activities.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are very fortunate to be able to offer school lunch orders again this year. Lunch orders will be offered each **Thursday (commencing on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> February, 2019)**. These orders can only be made online and **orders must be placed before 8.30am on the day of order.**

Sue Denahy from Canteen Management Services (H & H Canteens), manages the outside service from the Moama Grammar School Canteen. She will receive your child's order online in the morning and it will be delivered to your child's classroom in time for lunch.

Sue will print off orders at 8.30am and therefore, any late orders will be missed. Unfortunately they do not offer cash orders at this stage.

### How To Order

#### To sign up:

1. Go to the quickcliq WEB PAGE to register [www.quickcliq.com.au](http://www.quickcliq.com.au)
2. In the top left corner click on SIGN UP and fill in and submit the form. When it asks for 'address' this is your home address not the school address.
3. You will receive an email with instructions to confirm your email address and activate your account

### Create Your Account

1. Enter your Login and Password in order to login to the website.
2. Select the "Add student" tab. Make sure to fill out all your child's details before selecting "Next"  
**NOTE:** in the section where you select your child's class, there is no option to select 'preschool' so could all parents/guardians setting up their preschool child's account select **pre primary**
3. Select the "Add credit" tab to add credit to your account. You can add funds to your account using PayPal, Visa, Mastercard or direct credit.  
**NOTE:** if you would like to add credit via direct deposit it will take 2 days to clear.
4. Select the "Add order" tab to add an order.

### To Order

1. Select 'add order'
  2. Select 'child'
  3. Select 'date'
  4. Select the meals you would like to order and add them to the order
  5. Confirm the order or if you have more than one child, click "Confirm and Place New Order" Tab.
- Once you have confirmed the order, you will receive a confirmation email from Our Online Canteen. You can also double check your order by clicking either the "Active Orders" tab or the "Transaction History" tab.
