Principal's Report – Term 1 Week 4

Professional Development

Over the past two weeks and into next week I have been attending a lot of professional development out of the school to assist with my transition as Principal at Moama Public School. This has been a great opportunity for me to network with other principals as well as regional staff from the Deniliquin office. On the down side, I have and will be out of school a bit, which I apologise for.

The professional development sessions I have completed either by myself or with other staff members are:

Positive Behaviour for Learning

During this session in Week 2 Ms Campbell and I completed a refresher course in this program. The program is very visible across the school already and we follow the PBL principles when dealing with positive and/or negative behaviours in the yard. Each and every child already knows the expectations both inside the classroom and out in the yard. Our school values of Respect, Responsibility and Achievement are very visible and all students can recite these. The main benefit of this session for me was to reinforce that we are doing is correct and that the program does have a positive impact for all students at our school.

Curiosity & Powerful Learning

This session was a very quick one at Deniliquin on Tuesday last week where I learnt about this program and what the expectations for the school will be in 2019. Four staff members will be attending further training on this in Albury on March 7th. The program is designed to improve the teaching and learning practices of all students in the school.

Principal Network Day at Deniliquin

Ms Catlow as Acting Assistant Principal and I attended this day last week. This day was designed to set out the expectations from a regional level for all schools within our area. This was a great day for me especially to network with other principals and to meet the key regional staff. I will be able to utilise these contacts whenever I have issues that I can't solve myself.

Start Up Conference in Wagga

On Thursday and Friday last week I attended this conference. Once again it was a great opportunity to network with key members of the department staff. I also learnt about the system requirements that I need to complete each and every day at school.

New Principal Induction Conference

From Wednesday to Friday this week I am travelling to Sydney for this conference. This is a compulsory conference for all beginning principals in NSW. I am looking forward to this and will relay some of my key learnings when I return.

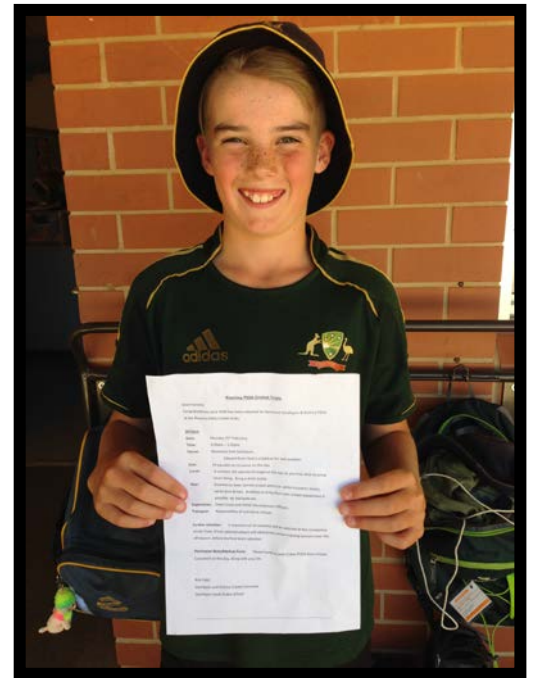


Champs!

Rhys participated enthusiastically at the trials and impressed the selectors and has now been selected to represent the Deniliquin District at the next level of the competition.



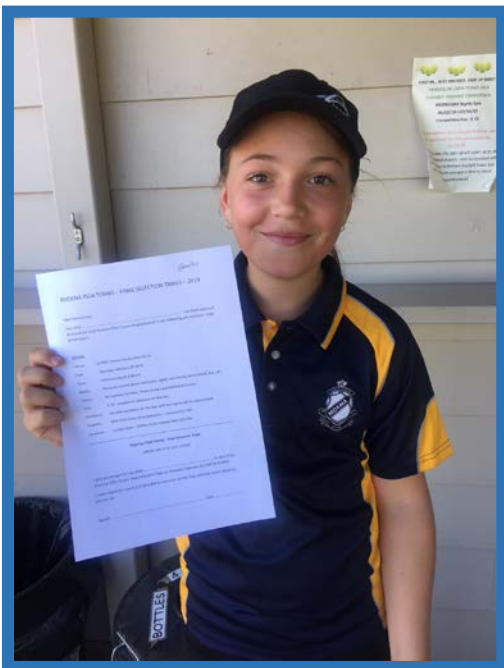
TENNIS TRIALS

Last Thursday Emily Lake and Madeline Williams travelled to Deniliquin to participate in the tennis trials. They were up against many other students from the Deniliquin District.

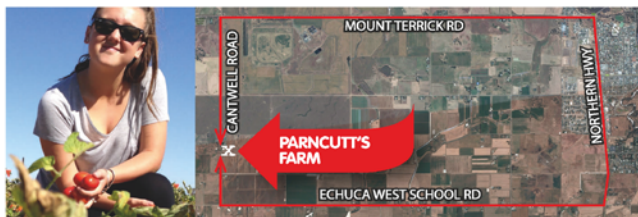
Both Emily and Madeline were great ambassadors for Moama Public with Emily being selected to go on to the next level and Madeline has been identified as a reserve.

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are very fortunate to be able to offer school lunch orders again this year. Lunch orders will be offered each **Thursday** this term. These orders can only be made online and **orders must be placed before 8.30am on the day of order.**

Sue Denahy from Canteen Management Services (H & H Canteens), manages the outside service from the Moama Grammar School Canteen. She will receive your child's order online in the morning and it will be delivered to your child's classroom in time for lunch.

Sue will print off orders at 8.30am and therefore, any late orders will be missed. Unfortunately they do not offer cash orders at this stage.

How To Order

To sign up:

1. Go to the quickcliq WEB PAGE to register www.quickcliq.com.au
2. In the top left corner click on SIGN UP and fill in and submit the form. When it asks for 'address' this is your home address not the school address.
3. You will receive an email with instructions to confirm your email address and activate your account

Create Your Account

1. Enter your Login and Password in order to login to the website.
2. Select the "Add student" tab. Make sure to fill out all your child's details before selecting "Next"
NOTE: in the section where you select your child's class, there is no option to select 'preschool' so could all parents/guardians setting up their preschool child's account select **pre primary**
3. Select the "Add credit" tab to add credit to your account. You can add funds to your account using PayPal, Visa, Mastercard or direct credit.
NOTE: if you would like to add credit via direct deposit it will take 2 days to clear.
4. Select the "Add order" tab to add an order.

To Order

1. Select 'add order'
 2. Select 'child'
 3. Select 'date'
 4. Select the meals you would like to order and add them to the order
 5. Confirm the order or if you have more than one child, click "Confirm and Place New Order" Tab.
- Once you have confirmed the order, you will receive a confirmation email from Our Online Canteen. You can also double check your order by clicking either the "Active Orders" tab or the "Transaction History" tab.
