### **Moama Community ANZAC Day Service**

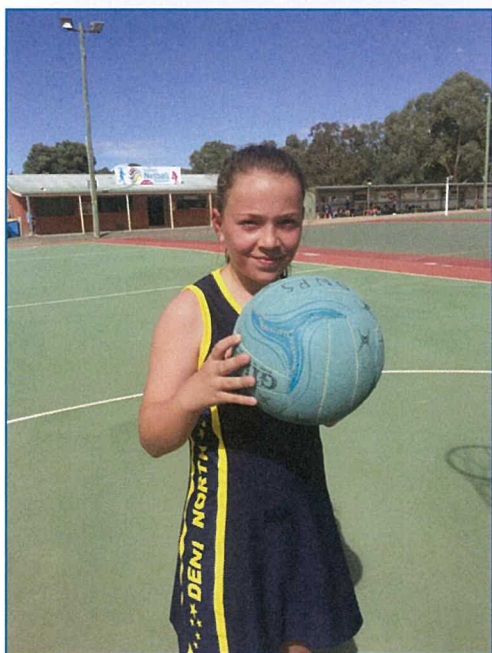
The choir will also be performing at the Moama community ANZAC service commencing at 9.00am on Thursday, April 25.

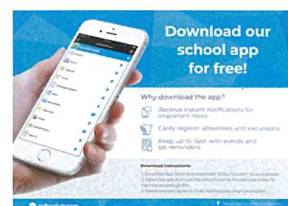

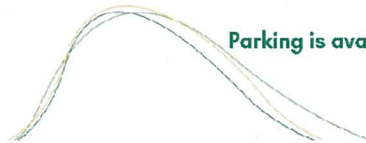

### PSYCHOLOGY

Larelle is a registered psychologist working with children, adolescents and their parents. Larelle originally trained and worked as a classroom teacher, through which she developed a strong interest in learning difficulties and differences, youth anxiety and depression, and developmental disorders such as Autism Spectrum Disorder and Intellectual Disabilities. Larelle has experience working as an internal school psychologist as well as in student support outreach roles.

In her assessment work, Larelle uses valid and reliable tools to measure cognitive abilities, academic achievement, and child behaviour. She provides practical recommendations with a focus on using strengths to maximise potential. In her therapeutic work, Larelle uses evidence-based approaches, including Acceptance and Commitment Therapy and other cognitive and behavioural techniques, to assist children and adolescents with a range of social and emotional difficulties. She also works with parents or carers to assist them in understanding and responding to their child's emotions and behaviour.

Larelle's fees are \$700 + GST for cognitive assessments & \$1100 + GST for educational assessments.
